Special Notes and General Rules:

1. No Santa allowed. He will be provided by the Unity Group
2. Horse groups must provide cleanup for their animals—Horse group will be allowed weather dependent--maybe subject to approval by the parade committee. PLEASE notify Parade Chair for more info.
3. Any injury resulting from the throwing of candy from units will be the responsibility of the parties throwing it. *Our policy is to not allow the throwing of candy. If you want to give out candy please have walkers hand the candy out*
4. **There are no parade placards this year**—you will be placed in the staging area based on your float—size—number of participants and when you arrived. *Car groups and horse groups will be lined up either at North Brunswick High School or at the end of Division Drive. Only the first 15 parade entries will receive a placard.*
5. Please maintain at least 50 foot buffer from the float or unit in front of you!
6. **KEEP YOUR GROUP TOGETHER!! ALL CHILDREN MUST HAVE ADULT SUPERVISION AT ALL TIME!! NO EXCEPTIONS>>THANK YOU and BE SAFE!!**

7. Motorized Vehicle Participant Rules

Any individuals operating a motorized vehicle will adhere to the following guidelines as set forth by the Chief of Police for the Leland Police Department.

1. No rapid acceleration or deceleration maneuvers
2. No spinning or burning of tires
3. No “wheelies” or acrobatic type maneuvers
4. No hands free steering of vehicle

These rules are placed into effect as a matter of public safety. Any violations noted during the parade will subject the operator to possible charges of careless or reckless operation of a vehicle.

8. No alcoholic beverages will be allowed during the parade.
9. No pets or animals allowed on the float. (SMALL animals maybe allowed upon prior approval)
10. No one under 18 years old may drive a float in the parade
11. Please ---no continuous blowing of sirens and horns while in the parade.
12. Car Clubs will be counted as a single entry—(10 cars max-each additional vehicle may require an additional fee) cars) How many vehicles? _____
