Special Notes and General Rules:

1. No Santa allowed. He will be provided by the Unity Group
2. Horse groups must provide cleanup for their animals—**call for approval before submitting**-allowing horse groups is weather dependent with a mandatory approval of the Board of Directors prior to the parade.
3. Any injury resulting from the throwing of candy from units will be the responsibility of the parties throwing it. Our policy is **not to allow throwing candy. If you want you may have walkers hand it out to the crowd.**
4. You will receive an entry number placard. You need to place this number in your window before arriving at the beginning of the parade route.
5. Please maintain at least 50 foot buffer from the float or unit in front of you!
6. **KEEP YOUR GROUP TOGETHER!! ALL CHILDREN MUST HAVE ADULT SUPERVISION AT ALL TIME!! NO EXCEPTIONS>>THANK YOU and BE SAFE!!**

7. Motorized Vehicle Participant Rules via Leland PD

Any individuals operating a motorized vehicle will adhere to the following guidelines as set forth by the Chief of Police for the Leland Police Department.

1. No rapid acceleration or deceleration maneuvers
2. No spinning or burning of tires
3. No “wheelies” or acrobatic type maneuvers
4. No hands free steering of vehicle

These rules are placed into effect as a matter of public safety. Any violations noted during the parade will subject the operator to possible charges of careless or reckless operation of a vehicle. I understand that I and our organization-float or any or all of the participants can be removed from the parade lineup and continued violation maybe subject to criminal violation.

8. No alcoholic beverages will be allowed during the parade or at the festival location.
9. No pets or animals allowed on the float. **Some exceptions but you need to call before submitting**
10. No one under 18 years old may drive a float in the parade
11. Please ---no continuous blowing of sirens and horns while in the parade.
12. Car Clubs will be counted as a single entry—(need to know how many cars)
